4. Does it matter where we gather Sunday if we don't love our neighbors on Monday? How would you answer that question?
5. Do you struggle to believe that the secret weapon of the Church, of Front Yard Missions, could be something as straightforward as hospitality? If it is the secret weapon why are we oftentimes so slow to see it and embrace it?
6. Do you agree that our church buildings have the potential to become the basket that hides our lights from our neighbors? Why or why not?
7. What is your FYM next step?
