

Lifting Christ Up - Life Group Questions

1. Have each of us signed up for the Revive prayer mission? If not, what about this call to prayer is giving you pause? (not looking to make anyone feel guilty but could generate some good conversation about prayer)
2. God is not calling us back to normal; He's calling us to go deeper. What does that idea of "going deeper with God" look like to you? How can we be intentional about moving in the direction of deeper?
3. Pastor Dan talked about the uncertainty that we've all been dealing with during this time of quarantine and social distancing. How would you describe your typical response to uncertainty? (Look to God, try to research needed facts, focus on areas of life that you can control, etc) Why do you respond to uncertainty in the ways that you do?
4. I love the idea that the earth is already filled with the glory of God; what He wants to do is flood the earth with the *knowledge* of His glory. How can we be more intentional about helping to fill the earth with the knowledge of God's glory? (dream big but also get practical)
5. Read John 1:14. Filling the earth with the knowledge of God's glory means that the earth must be filled with the knowledge of Christ. Let's bring it a bit closer to home. How can we be more intentional about filling our own hearts with the knowledge of the glory of Christ? Our families? Our neighborhoods?
6. Pastor Dan told us that when it comes to looking into the glorious face of Jesus seeing is not believing; seeing is becoming. Read 2 Corinthians 3:18. We are shaped by what we see. What are you giving your eyes to? What are the eyes of your heart focusing on?
7. We live in the midst of an epic battle but we overcome through the hope we have in Jesus. The message of Revelation is that Jesus is the triumphant king. What can we do to bring our vision of Jesus (and of ourselves) into line with God's word?

Take some time to pray the Dry Bones prayer together. Pray that Jesus would have our whole hearts and for revival!
