

## The Same Thing - Life Group Questions

### Sermon Discussion Questions:

1. Something that Dan and Stacy have mentioned in their sermons the last two weekends is the idea of capturing what the Lord is speaking to us during this time; a word or thought that we dare not forget. Do you feel as if you've heard what your word is? If not, will you commit to spending the time needed to listen for it?
2. Read Ezekiel 37:11-14. Ezekiel is told to prophesy that the breath of God would fill these bodies with life. Do you believe that God is asking us to prophesy over our towns and neighborhoods? Why or why not?
3. Where in your life do you see dry bones? In the midst of your own dry bones do you believe that God wants to use you to help bring His life into the dry bones of your family, work place, and neighborhood? Why or why not?
4. Pastor Stacy said that part of what God is doing in the world is creating an army of people, who are capable, strong, valiant, virtuous, and able. How does this description align with how you see yourself?

### Front Yard Mission Questions:

1. What is one of the most encouraging things that has happened within the context of your own Front Yard Mission?
2. Maybe you haven't committed to the idea of Front Yard Mission. If not, what would you say is the primary obstacle for you?
3. Take a moment to picture what your Front Yard Mission might look like if you were totally nailing it. Do you think the idea that you just pictured was designed by you or by God? Why?
4. What might be the next step that you can take this week to move toward God's dream for your Front Yard Mission?
