

## A Turn Of The Page - Life Group Questions

1. The glory of God moved from the Tabernacle to the Temple and from the Temple to the Church. What does it mean for the Church to be where God's glory resides? How should we live based on this truth?
2. Pastor Dan said that if God is the author of your story then hope is the story of your life. How can we consistently be people who walk in hope? Read Hebrews 6:17-19. How does this hope differ from simply "hoping" things get better?
3. We were asked to sign up to spend some time each day to prayerfully consider our ways. Have you committed to do this? Why or why not? (Don't shy away from this question! It's a great way to help encourage and lead your group toward engagement.)
4. We would all say that we don't want to miss the story that God is writing but we also can so easily become distracted by the things of the world (worry, anxiety, comfort, control, etc). What is your biggest hurdle to giving your focus to God first?
