

My Story Has A Team - Life Group Questions

1. Pastor Dan talked about the reality that as children of the King we have glory being written into our stories. We also sang a song at Flood that stated that if our story isn't good then it isn't finished. How do these statements resonate with you? How do you process the rubble in the midst of the glory?
2. When we get good at what we do we often forget how desperately we need the hand of God in our lives. In what ways have you found this statement to be true in your own life? How can we counteract that tendency?
3. Pastor Dan shared a quote from George Mueller that said, "Prayer is not overcoming God's reluctance, it's laying hold of His willingness." In which of these two ways of seeing prayer do you find yourself? Why do you think that is?
4. Can you think of someone (maybe a few people) who you believe that God is putting you on their team? If so, what are some ways that you can be intentional about coming alongside them in support and encouragement? If nobody comes to mind what steps can you take to find your team?
