

Stories Worth Sharing - Life Group Questions

1. Pastor Dan talked about our desire to be part of a great story. We want our lives to have meaning and purpose and impact. Where is it in your family, neighborhood, workplace, or school that you would most like to enter into the story God is writing? What might keep you from leaning in?
2. If we want to be part of God's good story then we have to be willing to enter into the good work that God is doing as He writes the story. Where is God calling you to join Him in His good work? (prayer and fasting, FYM, sharing your life/faith, etc)
3. It can be difficult to move with faith into God's good story if we believe ourselves to be disqualified. In what ways do you wrestle with believing that God can (and wants to) use you? What belief do you have about yourself that is not aligned with who God says you are?
4. **Going Deeper:** Take ten minutes each day this week to pray for these things:
 - a. Pray for a renewed confidence in your identity in Christ as a new creation
 - b. Pray that the Holy Spirit would reveal places where you are allowing your past, or present fears, to keep you from living the full life the Father wants for you.

Front Yard Mission Questions:

1. It seems that almost everyone who worked on the wall is named in the book of Nehemiah; except the nobles of Tekoa. They wouldn't put their shoulders to the work. In what ways have you found yourself struggling to consistently put your shoulders to the work in your FYM? How can we encourage and support you?
2. How are you going to use Halloween to connect with and bless your FYM this week?

Take some time to pray for each other during your meeting. It may be good to focus your prayer time on the answers given to question #3.
