Pursuing And Pursued - Life Group Questions

- 1. What are the connections that you see between our understanding of the character of God (holiness, righteousness, faithfulness, etc) and the way we look at our sin?
- 2. Pastor Dan talked about the difference between a "sinner" and an "oopster." What do you see as the difference between the two? How do you typically view yourself? What about others?
- 3. Sin is not just a failure to reach God's standards; it's a failure to treasure His heart. What are some of the fundamental lies and/or twisted truths about sin (or about God) that cause you to pursue sin over God?
- 4. If you were to renew your vows to God what would it look like? What would you say? Are there any specific things that you would vow to lay down or pick up?

Front Yard Mission Questions:

- 1. How might our willingness to view ourselves as a sinner (rather than an oopster) impact the way we view our neighbors?
- 2. Sin is a failure to treasure God' heart. God's heart is for our neighbors; He treasures them enough to send His son for them. Part of how we treasure God's heart is by treasuring what His heart treasures. How can you treasure God's heart in your FYM this week?
