1. Acknowledge the rubble; inherit the rubble; own the rubble. Pastor Dan said that how we see the rubble will determine how we respond to it. How do you understand the difference between these three ways of looking at the brokenness in and around our lives? Where would you place yourself in those options?
2. Pastor Dan said that we need God-chasers more than we need church-goers. How can we be intentional to continue growing as a God-chaser? How can we encourage those around us to not settle for being church-goers?
3. The Israelites gave Tobiah (the man who had opposed God and them) a room in the temple. Scripture tells us that we are the temple of God. Where have we made room for sin in our own hearts?
4. What structural change is God leading you to make so that you don't end up drifting back to normal (busyness, distractedness, apathy, etc)?

Front Yard Mission Questions:

1. How might the church being comfortable with being church-goers rather than God-chasers affect the way the world views us?
2. What structural changes might the Holy Spirit be leading you to make so that you can more fully engage in your FYM?
3. What is one step you can take this week to love and serve your neighbors?
