

What If Jesus Lived In My House - Group Questions

1. Share a time in your life when you experienced something that surpassed your expectations and you just couldn't help but tell people about it (a movie, a restaurant, a vacation, meeting someone famous, a certain book, a sunset, a painting, etc). What made you tell people about it?
2. C.S. Lewis puts it this way, "I think that we delight to praise what we enjoy because the praise not merely expresses but completes the enjoyment; it is its appointed consummation." If this holds true the more thoroughly we are enjoying our relationship with Christ the more natural it will be for us to talk about Him. What holds us up?
3. We all understand that Jesus would be an amazing neighbor but the reality that we seem at times to miss is that He really truly does live in us if we are His disciples. How does Jesus want to love and serve your neighbors through your life?
4. There is no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus but there can still be room for honest questions. What message does my way of living in my neighborhood communicate to my neighbors about Jesus (Jesus is super busy, Jesus is easily annoyed, never home, too hard to get to know, welcoming and caring, easy to talk to)?
