

What If It's Different - Discussion Questions

1. A term that has been used often around Front Yard Mission is, "Pray first, Love all, Invite often." Pastor Jorn said that there is something that can be a bit more difficult, or intimidating, about the "invite" piece. Is there one of these three areas that is more difficult/intimidating for you? Why do you think that is?
2. Jorn talked about the potential for a change in how we approach our neighbors. Do you think that there may be a shift needed in how your efforts to connect with your neighbors? What is working and what isn't? What's something new you could try?
3. Another point that Jorn made was that we may have wrong assumptions (about ourselves, our neighbors, or God) that need to be dealt with. What are some wrong assumptions that you may be holding onto about yourself? Your neighbor? God?
4. How can we keep in front of us the reality of our need for the power of the Holy Spirit in our lives to do Front Yard Mission well? What steps can we take to keep from relying on our own ability?

Front Yard Mission Questions:

1. How are you going to invite a neighbor into your life this coming CWOW Sunday?
2. What struggles are you seeing/feeling within the context of your FYM?

Take some time to pray over one another; specifically in regards to the upcoming CWOW Sunday and the answers given to FYM question #2.
