Always Room #2 – Our Front Yard Mission

1. God's Word clearly teaches that Jesus is fully God (His deity) and fully man (His humanity). In what way is the true story in Mark 2:1-12 a powerful statement about Christ's deity?

2. In Mark 2:1-12, Jesus forgave this man's sin before he healed his body. Do you see any special significance in the order in which He did those two things?

3. The true story in Mark 2:1-12 also occurs in Matthew 9 and Luke 5. What *similarities*, and what *differences* do you see in those three accounts of the same story?

4. Dr. Murray pointed out four ways these men brought their friend to Jesus. What were those four ways? Can you think of additional ways they used to get their friend to Jesus?

5. The four men faced obstacles in bringing their friend to Jesus. What obstacles do *you* face in trying to bring your friends and neighbors to Jesus? How can those obstacles be overcome?

6. In the story in Mark 2:1-12 someone allowed their house to be used as a place where people could come and find out more about Jesus. This was the ultimate in hospitality! What are some ways you could use your house or apartment for the same purpose?

7. Which of the four men in Mark 2:1-12 got the most recognition and credit for bringing the paralyzed man to Jesus?

8. Can you think of other believers with whom you can join hands intentionally in order to introduce more of your friends and neighbors to Jesus? How might you do that?

9. Make a list of the people whom you would like to bring to Jesus from the following spheres:
Your immediate/extended family
Your immediate neighborhood
Your work place
