

LifeGroup Questions  
Come and See #4 – Our Untamed Warrior

1. Read Mark 1:21-45. As we read the gospels keep these three paths in mind. Listen. Learn. Lean. Ask yourself what am I hearing from this passage for me personally? What have I learned about Jesus, what principles for life, what promises, what perspectives do I learn from this scripture? Finally ask where does God want me to lean in on this scripture? How should I respond?
2. Dan said that Mark's gospel is marked by battles. How does it help you understand your life if spiritual battle is real? How should we respond to spiritual battle?
3. Dan talked about three different battles. The first was the battle for redemptive change. Where in your life or the life of someone you care about is there a need for redemptive change? Take some time before you leave these questions to pray for the need.
4. The second battle was the battle for a holy calling. Jesus was called to something deeper than just a wonder-working mission. He had a holy gospel calling. What is your holy calling? Where do you need to be on the alert so that you don't settle for a hollow calling?
5. The final battle was the battle for restoration in community. What relationships in your life are in need of restoration? What needs to happen for restoration to take place? Who are the lepers (socially outcast, spiritually rejected) in your circle? How can you restore them to community?
6. Dan closed with two prayer; Jesus defend me and Jesus make me dangerous. Which prayer is most important to you right now? Why?
7. In these first few weeks of "come and see" and reading through the gospels. What is most compelling to you about Jesus?
