

Growing Up With Jesus - Life Group Questions

1. Pastor Dan opened his message with the statement that sometimes we, for differing reasons, aren't very good listeners when it comes to God. What do you see as some of the greatest distractions in your life?
2. In what ways have you noticed that you have lost some of the awe and wonder that you had toward Jesus earlier in your walk with Him?
3. What are your thoughts about Pastor Dan's statement that, perhaps, what the modern church should be most concerned with is our loss of amazement toward Jesus? Do you see this as a problem in your own life?
4. Pastor Dan stated that Jesus Christ is our sovereign king. He lays claim to the totality of our lives. How does that statement cause you to feel (fearful, joyful, worried, hopeful)? What thoughts go through your mind?
5. If we want to keep our wonder we'll need to remind ourselves (preach to ourselves) the reality of the Gospel message. Have you ever tried this? What are some ways that you can get in the habit of preaching the truth to yourself each day?
6. Another point that Dan made was to say that one of the ways that we can regain our amazement is to focus our eyes on heaven. What are some of the reasons why we aren't consistent to do this?
7. God seems to reserve the demonstration of His glory to those who have taken the risk to go out on His mission. In what ways are you being called to mission? What are some of the obstacles that keep you from fully embracing God's mission?
8. Share a story of when you were amazed by Jesus. End your time together by asking Jesus to amaze you again.
