Encounters with Jesus lead to Restoration

Luke 19:1-10 Zacchaeus

1. *Desperation and hope are cousins.* What did Stac mean by this, and do you agree? How could desperation and hope be linked?
2. Stac said, “At the end of your rope, you can climb when there is hope.” Talk about a time that you felt like you were at the end of your rope. What did you do to find hope?
3. Read John 14:6. Jesus makes it clear that he is the one and only way to be reconciled to Father God. Partner up with someone in your group and share your story. What has been your experience with Jesus. Have you asked him to be your Savior, and if so, how has that affected your life?
4. Stac said that Jesus looked up at Zacchaeus and He knew...What does Jesus know about you today that he wants to address?
5. What would you and Jesus talk about if he came to your house today?
6. Every encounter with Jesus should lead to repentance and restoration. That’s what we see with Zacchaeus. What has that looked like in your life?
7. Do you have a “Least Likely to come to Jesus” list? Are there people you don’t expect to come to Christ? Who are you praying for and inviting into your life?
8. Are you using the #Prayfor8 card? Talk about what’s going well, and where you think you might use a little help. Could a coaching conversation help you get unstuck?
 - a. Pray for 8: Begin with prayer
 - b. Stop and wait: Listen to your neighbors

- c. Take a plate: Eat together
- d. Be a mate: Serve your neighbors
- e. Tell it straight: Share your story and invite them to join you!
