1. What stood out to you from Becky and Kim's story of jogging right into an amazing Front Yard Mission story?
2. Pastor Dan started off his message by reminding us that we have been sent. We have been given the mission to not enter into eternity alone. Do you see yourself as being sent out on mission? What does that mean to you?
3. Pastor Dan talked about the difference between "winning people to Jesus" verses preparing them for Jesus. What do you see as some of the key differences between those two thoughts?
4. The first invitation that we need to give is to invite Jesus into the mission. Pray first. Prayer is the greatest resource that we have available to us. What are some of the reasons why we are still so often slow to pray?
5. Dan said that the next Billy Graham might be recovering from a hellacious hangover right now. The next Beth Moore might be an opioid addicted mother. How should that understanding impact the way that we pray?
6. We were challenged to fill the air of our neighborhoods with prayers of blessing. We should pray for our neighbors the way that we pray for ourselves. In what ways have you found yourself making prayer for your neighbors more complicated than it needs to be?
7. The second invitation is to invite people into our lives. Specifically those who we see God at work in their lives. How can you be more intentional to create space to invite those people on your hashtag into your life?
8. Final invitation is to invite people into Kingdom life. One of the most effective ways to do that is to share your story...your story of what God has done/is doing in you life. How do you perceive your story? Do you see it as something worth sharing...why or why not?
