1. In this world we are going to have trouble...but take heart! How well are you doing in keeping your heart in the midst of all that is going on around you? What can you do to increase your heart?
2. Pastor Dan said that trouble is oftentimes found at the edge of breakthrough. Breakthrough is something that we have been given; it's already here. What can we do to see through the "fog" of trouble in order to see the breakthrough?
3. Pastor Dan asked if we are praying like "whatever" is possible. What are some of the "whatevers" that the Holy Spirit is putting on your heart to pursue in prayer?
4. When you hear that Jesus will do whatever you ask in His name what comes to your mind? Have you had times when you have prayed and didn't seem to get an answer? How have those experiences impacted your prayer life?
5. How would you describe what it means to pray "in His name?"
6. The idea of a helpless life still being a hope-filled life seems almost like a contradiction. Pastor Dan said that if we aren't full of hope it's probably because we haven't really believed and internalized the promises of God. What are your thoughts on that statement?
7. The door for Front Yard Mission has been thrown wide open by all that is happening. In what ways can you lean into your Front Yard Mission? How can you love, serve, pray for, encourage, give to your neighbors?
